Our Commitment

Although we are not legally required to publish a statement under Section 54 of the UK Modern Slavery Act 2015 due to our turnover size, we choose to do so voluntarily to reflect our core values.

Our Business and Supply Chains

We operate as a Property Maintenance providing a property renovation and refurbishment service to domestic and commercial sites based in the UK. Our supply chains primarily consist of main suppliers and UK-based material suppliers.

Our Practices

- **Employment:** We ensure all staff have the legal right to work in the UK and are paid fairly in accordance with UK employment regulations.
 - **Suppliers:** We expect our suppliers and subcontractors to uphold the same high standards. We do not knowingly work with any business involved in exploitation.
 - **Reporting:** Any signs of suspected modern slavery or human trafficking can be reported confidentially to company management.
